### B. Leadership:

1. A praying church or ministry requires praying leaders. "Whenever God calls His people to Himself, He uses His leaders." (Blackaby) "The prayer level of the church never grows beyond the personal example and passion of the senior leaders." D. Henderson

2. Lead others to pray by praying with them. We must call our people to prayer/spiritual activity.

C. Biblical Prayer: Enjoying the Power and Confidence of Scripture-Centered Prayer

1. God has chosen to obligate Himself to fulfill the promises in His Word. 2 Pet 1:3-4

"God's divine power has given us everything we need for life and for godliness... **he has given us his promises that are of the highest value. Through these promises you will share in the divine nature** because you have escaped the corruption that sinful desires cause in the world." 2 Pet 1:3-4

2. Relationship: We enjoy privilege of prayer because of our relationship with Christ. John 1:12-13

"As many as received Him.. He gave the **right to become children of God**, to those **who believe in His name**: **born**, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but **of God.** John 1:12-13 NKJV

a. God loves to hear your voice. God can tell your voice from the voice of others! Hebrews 13:15

Let's give praise to God for the precious promises from God's word that we are grateful for.

### 3. God's will is in His Word. We pray according to the promises in God's Word.

Psalm 119: 1-2, 9-11, 89-90; 2 Timothy 3:16, Hebrews 4:12, Matthew. 7:7, Isaiah 55:10-11

Pray these prayers over yourself from Psalm 119:9-11:

Lord, help me to keep my way pure. Help me keep my life according to Your word in these ways \_\_\_\_\_\_ Help me to treasure Your word in my heart in these areas \_\_\_\_\_\_ so I don't sin against you.

# F. Linking Prayer with Ministry – Examples from The Book of Acts

**1. Discipleship (2:42)** Train members to have an effective prayer life, disciple others in prayer, train their children to pray, etc.

**2. Evangelism - House to House (2:47)** Train members to pray for those the church is trying to reach, for the lost/those they are witnessing to, for opportunities to witness, for their neighbors, etc.

**3. Missions (13:1-3)** Train members to discern who to call to missions, pray for missionaries, for missions outreaches and events, for local and global mission activity, etc.

**4. Bold Witness – Community (4:33)** Train members to pray for the church to boldly impact the community, for God to open doors of opportunity, etc.

### G. Connecting With the God's Heart for Prayer and Evangelism – Through Prayer

Biblical prayer shows our dependence on God and connects us to the mission God has for us.
If we don't have Biblical prayer in our ministries, that is a leadership issue.

**<u>1. Love:</u>** John 3:16-17 God so loved the world that He gave Jesus so we might not perish but have eternal life. God did not give His son to condemn the world, but so that we might be saved thru Him.

Ephesians 2:4 Because of his great love for us, God, rich in mercy, made us alive in Christ.

Luke 15: Increase our love for that which was lost. Sheep (v. 3-7), Coin (v. 8-10), Son (v. 11-31)

Lord, increase our love for you. Increase our capacity to receive your love so that we have love to give to others. Increase our love for others. Increase our love for what was lost (Luke 19:10) Increase our desire to rejoice with heaven.

Luke 15:7 I tell you that in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance.

### 2. Laborers: Matt 9:36-38 Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers into the harvest.

Lord: Who are the harvesters? Where is the harvest – where are the fields ripe? Who will make themselves available to be harvesters? What can I do to help? We are fishing for men, Lord, where should we cast the net? Who has a sense of spiritual need?

# <u>3. Leadership / Spiritual Power:</u> Luke 4:18-19 Jesus was anointed to proclaim good news to the poor, to proclaim freedom for the prisoners, recovery of sight for the blind, set the oppressed free.

Lord, thanks for anointing God's people to proclaim good news that sets people free. Use us for your glory!



### 4-Quadrant Praying (con't)

**3. Ministry Prayer and Evangelism:** Seeking God's best for others by praying for and with them. (Ministering to Others in Prayer)

**a. Pray blessings**: *Blessing of God: "God's goodness , kindness, and favor on His children causing all that they do whether it be spiritual or temporal to prosper and succeed"* Dr. Huegel

b. What do I pray for?: Matt. 20:29-34 Ask - What do you want Jesus to do for you?"

Characteristics of a prayer intercessor: Serve, Listen, Compassion, Personal, Appropriate touch

**c. Provide faith for victory, confront obstacles:** Luke 5:17-20, 24-26 Pray for God to remove obstacles so the person's need can be met.

4. Corporate Intercession and Evangelism: Seeking God's will for us as a congregation or ministry.

**Prayer Partner or Group Prayer:** Pray with a prayer partner or small group to continue to pray for most wanted and for evangelism.

Church-wide: Pray for pastor's vision. Pray for church members to grow in prayer and evangelism.

Evangelism: Follow Bible example by going out 2 by 2, if possible

# Corporate Prayer: Let's Pray Together- Use spiritual "brainstorming" approach

"Again I say to you, that if **two believers on earth agree** [that is, are of **one mind, in harmony**] about anything that they **ask [within the will of God**], **it will be done for them by My Father in heaven**." Matthew 18:19 AMP

Pray **briefly enough** so that all can participate. Pray **loudly enough** so all can hear, agree and be edified. Pray h**umble prayers**: We can always pray for the Lord to reveal "truth, wisdom, insight, clarity, etc."

Prayer time should be *Inclusive: Harmonious, Relational: Connected to God and His promises and* each other in the group and Collective: Working together for good of whole.

How is God inviting us to grow as a church in: Love: John 3:16-17, Ephesians 2:4, Luke 15.

Laborers: Matthew 9:36-38
